

Build Your Own Maracas



Maraca Supplies:

2 plastic eggs

4 plastic spoons

Thick colored tape
(decorator maki tape,
duct, or electrical tape)

Dry beans

Directions:

1. Fill each of the two plastic eggs with dry beans so you can make 2 maracas.
2. Put colored tape all around the center divider of each egg so the eggs will not come apart. You don't want to spill your beans!
3. For each maraca, put an egg in between two plastic spoons and tape this part together. You can put one or two pieces of colored tape around the spoon that is holding the egg. Make sure the tape goes all the way around the spoons and eggs tightly.
4. Gently push the spoon handles together and put two strips of tape around the spoon handles to hold them together. Make sure the tape goes all the way around spoon handles tightly.
5. Have fun shaking your maracas to music and be sure to shake them for your family and friends!
